This Ontario College Graduate Certificate program provides professionals with specialized knowledge and skills in Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder (FASD) and service delivery to individuals, families and groups at risk for, or living with, FASD. The program requires completion of 11 courses, 540 hours of course work. This program is designed for professionals to provide knowledge and skills to improve FASD services, to impact policy development and to understand the complex challenges facing families, individuals and communities at risk for, or living with, FASD.

Effective prevention and intervention strategies, research and professionalism are emphasized so that services may be delivered in a respectful and culturally competent manner toward achieving balance and harmony in the context of wholistic health and healing of all community members.
